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## Your Contributions to Moving forward the JPP ERA-Net SES Initiative

The JPP ERA-Net SES initiative lives on the funded projects and their work bringing in valuable results, activities and achievements. To maximize impact and create cross-border and cross-project learning exchange and cooperation among projects are indispensable when finding solutions for cross-cutting challenges. Hence, it is one of our initiative's key features that **all funded projects and their representatives are active members of the JPP ERA-Net SES Knowledge Community and its Working Groups**. The JPP ERA-Net SES Support Team manages the Knowledge Community and Working Groups and thereby facilitates your active participation in these activities. Please note that all projects are required to be represented in the Working Groups, report to the initiative and run communication activities. Related costs are covered by the budget planned in your Knowledge Community Standard Work Package.

## Your Project's Reporting: Annual and Final Reporting

To make most of the results and receive feedback by experienced evaluators, JPP ERA-Net SES projects are required to regularly report to the initiative. **The reporting tool will be active from 16 January 2023 for all projects. The projects submitting an annual report have to do so by 14 March 2023.**

**Please note that for the projects ending in 2023, the following schedule applies:**

- projects, which end **by 30 June 2023**, have to submit a final report. The reporting deadline for each project will be the project's official end date in 2023.
- projects, which end **after 30 June 2023**, have to submit an annual report by 14 March 2023 and a final report by the project's official end date in 2023. For the final report you may build upon the information submitted for the annual report.

All listed project managers and owners have received an e-mail with a save-the-date on the reporting and will receive an e-mail with final information on the reporting in January.

- be a **registered expera expert** (register [here](#))
- be **listed as project manager/owner** or assigned by those as reporter for the project (changes to be communicated to [knowledgecommunity@eranet-smartenergysystems.eu](mailto:knowledgecommunity@eranet-smartenergysystems.eu))

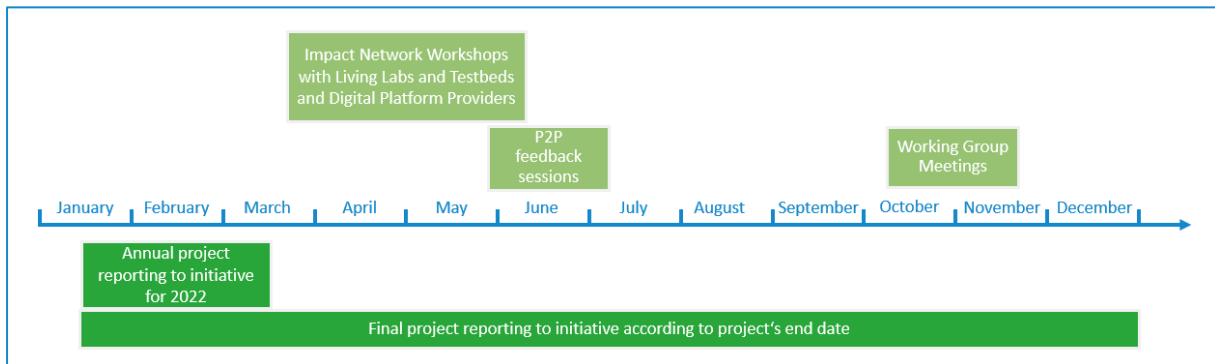
### **What's next?**

#### **Working Group Meetings in 2023**

The Working Groups will meet two times in virtual meetings. For 2023, the focus of the Working Group meetings will be the analysis of projects results and their (potential) impact. The first meeting round will be based on the evaluation of the [Your Project's Reporting: Annual and Final Reporting](#) and will have the format of peer-to-peer feedback sessions. These sessions provide the opportunity for all ongoing JPP ERA-Net SES funded projects to receive and share valuable feedback among peers. There will be five sessions; one per Working Group topic (see [Your Project's Participation and Representation in the Working Groups](#)). The Working Group meetings in autumn will be organized as a joint meeting of all five Working Groups to tackle cross-cutting topics relevant for all members of the Working Groups.
