About the event

The ERA-Net SG+ Working Groups are part of the European Knowledge Community bringing together experts and practitioners from the field of Smart Grids and beyond. There are five different groups focussing on the following topics:

- System Architecture and Modelling
- Consumer and Citizen Involvement
- Interoperability and Standardisation
- Regulatory and Market Development
- Storage and Cross Energy Carrier Synergies

The Working Groups enable knowledge sharing and exchange between representatives from industry and academia by building up long-term collaboration between its members and thus enabling a trustful relationship amongst its members. The plan is that Working Groups meet once a year physically plus virtually using the Knowledge Sharing platform expera where they can also contribute to the Living Documents.

In Split, there will be meetings of all five Working Groups (WGs) of the Knowledge Community. WG will first meet in parallel and then partially together. While three of the Working Groups already started in late 2015 / early 2016, the Working Groups on "Consumer and Citizen Involvement" and "Interoperability and Standardisation" will convene there for the first time. The connection of different Working Groups in one meeting enables an exchange of knowledge between the groups and discussion of cross-cutting topics.
